AWS Educate provides two different options for students to sign up. Students can sign up with an AWS account or they can opt to sign up under a starter account. The option for a starter account is exclusively for students without a credit card or an AWS account. 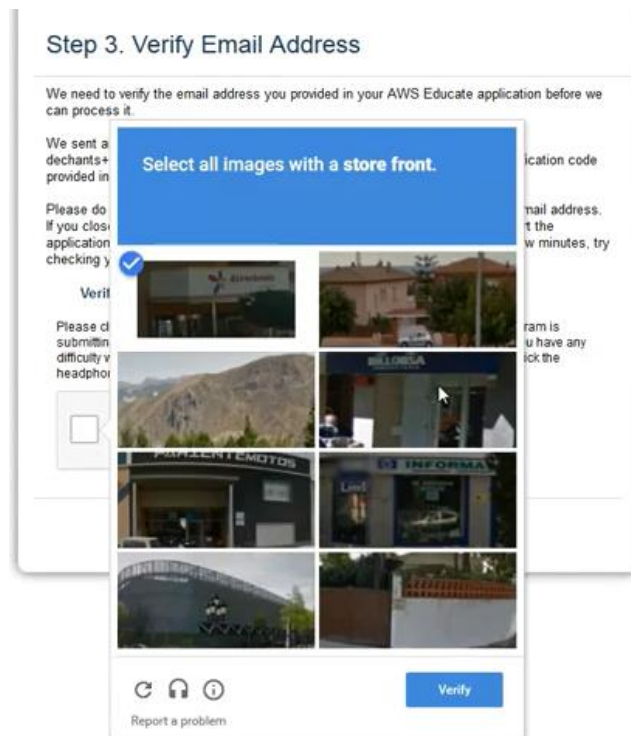
